

Obtaining the 30 hours Eligibility Code

Parents taking up the 30 hours free child care provision must submit an application to obtain an 11 digit eligibility code.

On accessing the Government site you will be asked to enter personal details including your name, address and National Insurance number and the same details for your partner (if applicable). You will also be asked whether you expect to meet the income requirements over the coming three months and whether you are in receipt of any relevant benefits.

This information will help HMRC decide whether the parent (and their child) are eligible for 30 hours provision. At the start of the application process, you will create a Government Gateway account if you don't already have one. If you encounter any problems with the application process or accessing the childcare account, please contact the Childcare Service Customer Interaction Centre on 0300 123 4097. At the end of the application process, if you are eligible, you will be given an 11 digit 'eligibility code' for your child.

The code should be included on the Coteford Infant School's Parent Declaration return for the Free 30 Hour Nursery Entitlement form, included in this pack. Please mark correspondence FAO Ms Harris. The School reserves the right to withdraw the offer of the 30 hours place if the code is not supplied to the school by this deadline.
