How you can help your child at home:

Below are some ways to support your child's learning, linked to what they are doing at school. These are just suggestions and are not "homework".

Literacy:

We are learning the Gingerbread Man Story, so we can say it with actions. This we call Talk 4 Writing.

To help your child, please ask if they can show you what they have learnt. They will love to perform it to you!

Maths:

We are looking at "place value". We are counting forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. We are counting, reading and writing numbers in numerals and words. We are using the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least. Given a number, we are identifying one more or one less.

To help you child at home please encourage them to count backwards from a given number.

Topic: We have begun our topic 'Food Glorious food'. We will be learning about where food comes from and how it gets to us.

You can help your child by talking to them when you go shopping or when cooking. Encourage them to think about where food comes from and how it got here. Explain that some food has had a long journey, to get to the supermarket. Look carefully at the packaging. Get them to bring in some packaging to show in class.
