## Our Learning: This Terms topic is 'Celebrations'

### This week

This week we have continued to practice adding two groups together counting all of them to find the answer and then beginning to count on from 1 group.

In literacy we have been writing labels using the word 'the' then trying to extend it into a sentence e.g. the cat is big. The frog is on the log.

We have been looking at birthday and how birthdays can be celebrated in different ways. We have been making birthday cards, decorations and making rice Krispy cakes.

On Thursday we had a road safety workshop. The children learnt how to cross the road safely. We learnt this rhyme to help us remember Stop, Look, Listen hold hands before you cross the street. Use your eyes use your ears before you use your feet

### How you can help at home

Play lots of adding games (Adding 2 single digit numbers up to 9 e.g. 3+4, 6+2)

2 groups of teddies

2 bowls of apples

2 piles of blocks

How many do we have altogether?

When your child is confident doing this begin to practice counting on.

Counting on e.g. 3 +3
