This week

This week have been exploring weighing. We have been talking about heavy light and comparing the weight of objects using words like lightest/heaviest/lighter/heavier.

In literacy we have been describing presents and guessing what we think is inside. We have also been making lots of cards focusing on writing to and from.

This week we had a nurse visit us she talked about her job and how we didn't need to be worried and scared if we needed to visit in the hospital.

How you can help at home

Find objects around the house talk about if they feel heavy or light. Challenge your child to find something that is lighter/heavier. Put 3 or 4 objects in order compare the sizes using the language lightest/heaviest/ lighter/heavier
