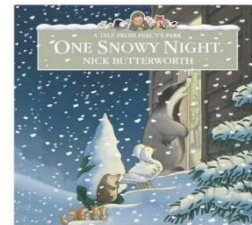

How you can help your child at home:

Below are some ways to support your child's learning, linked to what they are doing at school. These are just suggestions and are not "homework".

English:

We will continue with the 'Little Red Riding Hood'. We will also be writing a recount of our trip to Manor farm and the library and writing a firework safety poster. Our next talk for writing is One Snowy Night, By Nick Butterworth.

Each day we will have a short RWI phonics lesson in our reading groups.

Please encourage your child to learn their spellings. You can 'say, cover write and check'. Try to encourage your child to write them in a sentence, as this helps them to use them in their independent writing.

Maths:

In Maths we will be revisiting subtraction, mixed addition and subtraction and doing word problems. The following week we will learn how to do missing number addition and subtraction number sentences. You can help your child by using objects at home to add and subtract, jumping forward on a numberline to add and back to subtract. You can also help your child to practise counting backwards from any number (e.g. 19,18,...).

History and Geography:

We will continue our Out and About lessons by understanding that maps tell us the location of different places and finding key human and physical features in our local area.
